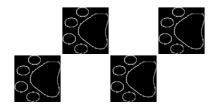

## SNOW AND COLD WEATHER CLOSINGS

Zion Lutheran School will follow the Staunton public school schedule for all inclement weather closings. Please watch the local news stations for Staunton CUSD 6 to appear. A Parent Alert text message or email will also be sent through RenWeb to all parents and closing information will be posted on the Zion Facebook page. Generally, the daycare will remain open in the event of a snow day. If the daycare would not have power, heat, water, or the weather conditions are unsafe for staff the daycare may close. You may check for daycare closings by listening to the WSMI radio station or checking the Zion Facebook page. Remember, if your child attends daycare on a snow day, they will need to have a sack lunch. Full and half day rates apply to snow days.
