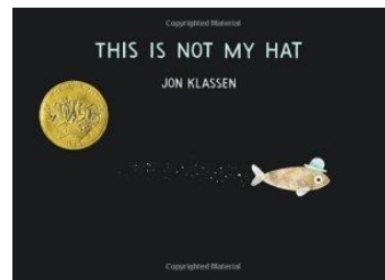

Reminders

- ❖ Do not wash or rinse your turkey before cooking
- ❖ Have a meat thermometer available
- ❖ Keep cold foods at 41°F or below
- ❖ Wash your hands frequently

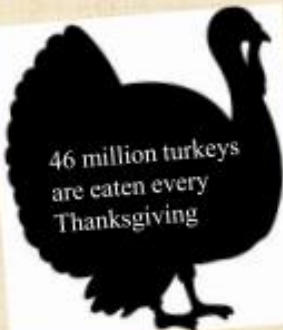


The tradition of breaking the wishbone for good luck was started by ancient Romans with chickens. The English adopted the tradition using turkeys and brought it to America through Plymouth Rock.

Dressing vs. Stuffing

No matter which term you use, proper cooking is crucial. If you "stuff" your turkey, the center of the dressing must reach a minimum of 165°F. If your dressing contains raw meat (such as sausage), you should precook the raw meat before "stuffing" the turkey to reduce the risk of foodborne illness from bacteria that may be found in the raw meat.

46 million turkeys are eaten every Thanksgiving

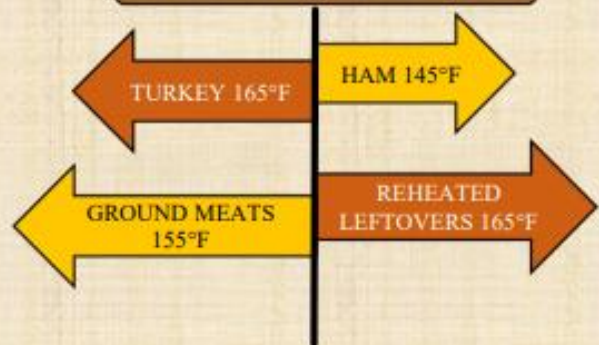


How to Safely Thaw a Turkey

- Refrigerator thawing (recommended)- it takes 24 hrs. for every 4-5 pounds
- Cold water thawing- 30 minutes/pound. Leave the turkey in its original packaging and submerge it in a sink or container full of cold water. The water should be changed every 30 minutes. Once thawed, cook immediately.
- Microwave thawing- check your owner's manual for minutes/pound and power level to use. Remove all outside wrapping and place turkey on microwave-safe dish. Use the defrost function based on weight. Once thawed, cook immediately.

**You can cook a frozen turkey. Just remember, it will take at least 50% longer to cook than a thawed turkey.

Pie Tips

Refrigerate pies that contain eggs and/or dairy. This includes pumpkin and pecan pies and any pie with a meringue topping or chiffon base.

Store-bought pies are stored and sold at room temperature because preservatives are added to make them shelf-stable. Once cut, store bought pies that contain eggs and/or dairy should be refrigerated.

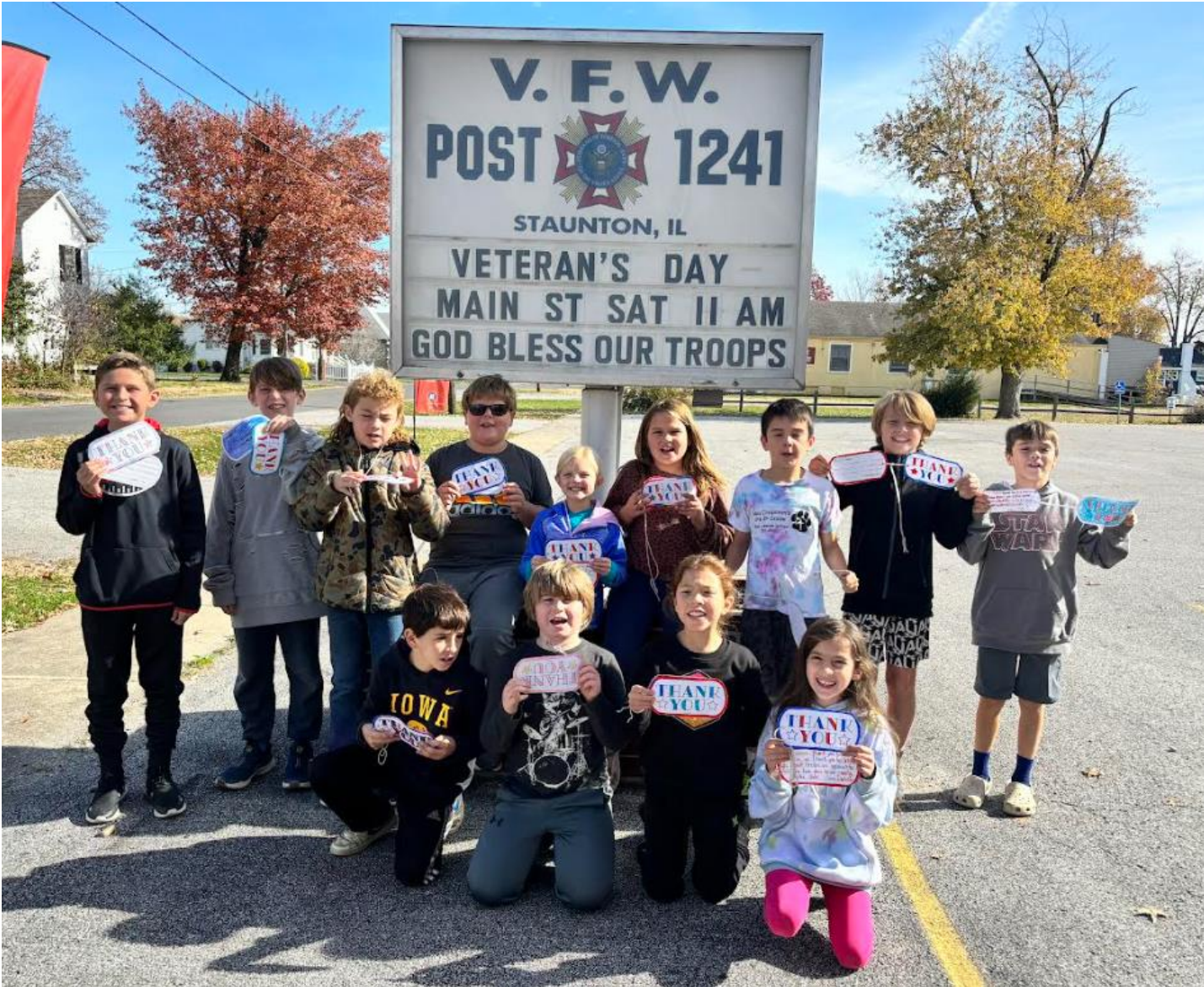
